Institute for Mining Research and Studies is a collective designation for the following three organizations:

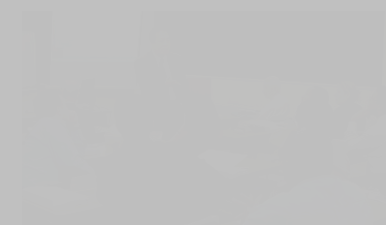
Akita Prefectural Resources Technology Development Organization
